

<b>Schedule of funeral fees at St John's from 1 April 2021</b>	
<p><b>Standard fee</b> (funeral or memorial service in St John's church)  <i>The standard funeral fee is normally paid to St John's direct by the funeral director and includes all of the following</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The priest who will be celebrant</li> <li>● Provision of a professional musician (organist) to play at the service</li> <li>● Support of the parish staff to assist in producing an order of service, advice and direction regarding music, and all other elements of the service</li> <li>● Flowers in the church: two large arrangements</li> </ul>	\$ 1900
<p><b>Attendance at the Committal</b>  <i>This further fee applies where the priest who will be celebrant is required to travel to a prior or subsequent service for the committal; typically this will be at the graveside or crematorium.</i></p>	\$ 150
<p><b>Buxton Hall</b>  <i>The beautifully appointed and decorated Buxton Hall, located on site at St John's, is an ideal venue for the wake and for refreshments after the service; the flat rate provides for two hours use, including use of trestle tables, and chairs. The St John's catering Guild may be able to provide catering – please contact the parish office to check their availability.</i></p>	\$ 250
<p><b>Soloist and / or St John's choir</b> (optional)  <i>St John's has an excellent choir, and qualified soloists, available to lead the singing of hymns and to perform anthems and other musical items, in consultation with the Director of Music.</i></p>	Soloist \$150 Choir POA
<p><b>Interment of Ashes</b>  <i>Following a cremation, the cremated remains may be interred in St John's memorial garden, and a page created in the Book of Memory located in the church (the page is opened on the anniversary of death each year)</i></p>	\$ 300 interment \$300 page in the Book of Memory
