SCHEDULE OF FUNERAL FEES 2026

Standard fee <i>Funeral or Memorial service in St John's church</i>	The standard funeral fee is normally paid to St John's direct by the funeral director and includes all of the following: ✦ The priest who will be celebrant ✦ Provision of a professional musician (organist) to play at the service ✦ Support of the parish staff to assist in producing an order of service, advice and direction regarding music, and all other elements of the service ✦ <i>Note: flowers are not provided and need to be organised by the funeral directors or family.</i>	\$2,100
Attendance at the Committal <i>(optional)</i>	This further fee applies where the priest who will be celebrant is required to travel to a prior or subsequent service for the committal; typically this will be at the graveside or crematorium.	\$300
Soloist / St. John's choir <i>(optional)</i>	St John's has an excellent choir, and qualified soloists, available to lead the singing of hymns and to perform anthems and other musical items, in consultation with the Director of Music.	\$280 <i>per singer</i>
Interment of Ashes <i>(optional)</i>	Following a cremation, the cremated remains may be interred in St John's memorial garden.	\$300
Book of Memory <i>(optional)</i>	A page may be entered onto the Book of Memory located in the church (the page is displayed on the anniversary of death each year).	\$300
Buxton Hall <i>(optional)</i>	The beautifully appointed and decorated Buxton Hall, located on site at St John's, is an ideal venue for the wake and for refreshments after the service; the flat rate provides for two hours' use, including use of trestle tables, and chairs. <i>Please provide your own caterer.</i>	\$550
